# 'Life in the Stone Age'; 'Life in Roman Britain'

## Our history topics for this half term

Our key question for Y4 history this term is, 'What was daily life like in Roman Britain?'

Pupils will learn about the Romans in the local area, including the construction of Hadrian's Wall.

Y3 will be learning about living long, long ago in the Stone

Age and how human society began to develop during this time.

Science this half-term for Y4 is all about electricity, including components and diagrams.

Y3 pupils are learning about rocks and soils, linked to their history topic.
